The main objective is volunteering in community centers and intergenerational houses that support seniors through everyday programs.

### PROJECT

AWO Stuttgart operates several Begegnungszentren (community meeting centres), which serve as meeting points for social interaction, cultural activities, and everyday support.

During your volunteering you will attend two trainings organized by the German National Agency (on-arrival and mid-term training).

You will become part of an experienced team and a supervisor will be available to answer your questions at any time. You will have the opportunity to meet other volunteers. Your hosting organisation will also provide additional German classes depending on your level.



### MAIN ACTIVITIES

Our facilities offer a wide range of programs, helping seniors lead independent and active lives:

- You will assist in planning, organizing, and carrying out recreational, educational, and cultural activities for the visitors (ex. game nights, craft sessions, lectures...)
- You will support our visitors by providing transportation services
- You will assist our visitors with everyday tasks such as filling out forms, accompanying them...
- You will run errands for the facility or our visitors, whether it's for daily needs or special events.
- You will work with the team and take on general organizational tasks (event preparation, administration...)

- You will live in either a shared apartment or a residential home with other young adults who are new to Germany.

- You will receive monthly pocket money and food allowance according to ESC guidelines.
